

## **Aerangis hyaloides**

**Found in Madagascar in shady locales in moss forests at elevations of sea level to 1000 meters as a miniature epiphyte with a very short stem carrying 2 to 8 closely set, elliptic, unequally bilobed apically, coriaceous, dark glossy green leaves with somewhat erect, racemose, 2 to 2 3/4" [5 to 7 cm] long, inflorescence carrying from 6 to 20 glistening white flowers occurring in the winter.**
